ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (414 City & County Building), and that on the 14th day of November, 1983, Case No. 9457 by Young Electric Sign Company for Holiday Inns of America was heard by the Board. The applicant requested a variance on the property at 1659 West North Temple Street to erect a double-face, free-standing sign which would exceed the permitted height limit in a Commercial "C-1" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Beginning 660 feet North from the St corner of Section 34, TlN, RlW, SLB&M, running S0°59'04"E 150 feet, more or less; East 150 feet; North 150 feet; West 150 feet to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and passed with one negative vote that a variance be granted to erect a double-face, free-standing sign which would exceed the permitted height limit by three feet making the sign 28 feet in height instead of the permitted 25 foot height limit. If a permit has not been taken out in six months, the variance will expire.
