Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 25, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian and running thence north 150 rods, thence East 22 rods, thence South along the Bamberger Railroad Right of Way, ^{150 rods} thence West 23 rods to place of beginning.

County of Davis, and State of Utah and upon and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least forty-eight inches, to erect and set the two necessary anchors and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.
