To amend, that exterior air conditioning devices be permitted (Swamp Coolers), as long as a low profile unit is used and mounted on the rear side of roof. Not to be seen from the front street. Not to be mounted on the roof ridge. Prior approval of Architectural Control Committee is required.

Further amended that Channel #1 antennas be permitted on rooftops. Must only be mounted in a location where as not to be seen from the front of the house. These are to be mounted on the roof only high enough to clear the top ridge or to be effective. All other antennas must be mounted in the attic. AS TO "SATTELITE SAUCERS", they will be permitted, provided, they must be in the rear of the home and below the level of the fence, or six feet.....

Further amended, and permitted will be the need of Patio Awnings or cover to a patio, Also where a westerly or a Southerly view requires window awnings to shad sun, or shutters for ornimental value, permitted. These features must be of a material to match the home, color etc. all work to be done in a pfofessional manner. Prior approval of the Architectural Committee is required....
