

Resolution # 2085

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE THE CREATION OF A SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT AND THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED THEREIN, PROVIDING FOR A HEARING ON THE CREATION OF SAID SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT, PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SAID HEARING AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, Utah, believes that the proper management of public recreation to ensure future economic growth requires the undertaking of projects and improvements in public recreation within specified areas of the County and therefore it is desirable to incorporate said area into a Special Service District pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Special Service District Act, Chapter 23, Title 11, Utah Code Annotated, 1953 as amended, and Article XIV, Section 8 of the Constitution of Utah; and

WHEREAS, all property included within the boundaries of said proposed Special Service District will be benefited by the creation thereof; and

WHEREAS, none of the area to be contained within the boundaries of said proposed Special Service District is also within the boundaries of any other special service district established by said County to establish recreation projects and contribute to recreational activities and projects, nor is the area within any other district presently providing similar services:
