

medium of the air upon each and every portion of said lands any and all gases, dust, dirt, fumes and other substances and matter which may be released, given, or thrown, or blown off, emitted or discharged in the course of, or by, or through the existence or operations of each and all of the smelting plants, reduction works, mills, manufactures, tailing deposits, and other works and factories which now are, or which may hereafter at any time be established or operated by said corporations, or any of them, or by their, or either or any of their grantees, successors, assigns, or lessees, within Salt Lake County, Utah.

For himself, his heirs and assigns, and by accepting this deed, the grantee, covenants and agrees with the grantor, its successors and assigns, that no residence hereafter erected on said land shall cost less than \$750.00. However, necessary outhouses may be erected at a less cost, but it is understood that no buildings shall be used in the conduct of any trade or business, or otherwise, than a private dwelling or an outhouse, and that no part of any such building shall be nearer than 15 feet from the front property line.




