**ASSIGNMENT
OF
PERMITS**

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF PERMITS (this “Assignment”) is made and entered into on this 1st day of November, 2017 (the “Effective Date”), by and between STICHTING MAYFLOWER MOUNTAIN FONDS, a Netherlands association, and STICHTING MAYFLOWER RECREATIONAL FONDS, Netherlands association, (collectively, “Assignors”), and BLX MAYFLOWER LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (“Assignee”).

A. Assignors as Sellers, and Assignee as Buyer, entered into a certain Amended and Restated Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement, dated to be effective as of October 18, 2016 (as may be amended from time to time, the “REPSA”).

B.

B. Assignors own all right, title and interest in, to and under certain Permits (as defined in the REPSA) relating to the Real Property, which Real Property includes the real property identified on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

C. Assignors desire to assign to Assignee, as of the Effective Date, all of Assignors’ right, title and interest in, to and under the Permits, and Assignee desires to receive from Assignors such assignment and to assume the obligations of Assignors under the Permits to be performed following the Effective Date.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and conditions contained herein, the Assignors and Assignee hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignment. Assignors hereby assign and transfer to Assignee all of Assignors’ right, title and interest in to and under the Permits, effective as of the Effective Date.

2. Assumption. Assignee hereby accepts such assignment and assumes, effective as of the Effective Date, all obligations of Assignors under the Permits arising on and after the Effective Date and agrees to be bound by and perform all of Assignors’ obligations under the Permits from and after the Effective Date.

3. Effect on REPSA. Notwithstanding the foregoing, and for the avoidance of doubt, nothing herein is intended to expand, restrict, or create any additional obligations, covenants, representations and warranties or alter or amend any of the obligations, covenants, representations and warranties set forth in the REPSA.

4. Further Assurances. Upon the reasonable request of Assignee, Assignors agrees to execute any additional documents which may be required to fully carry out the intent hereof.

5. Miscellaneous. Any term not defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in the REPSA. This Assignment shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of


Utah, and Assignors and Assignee consent to personal jurisdiction in the State of Utah. This Assignment may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which shall constitute a single agreement. This Assignment shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors in interest and assigns. 
