ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (324 South State Street, Room 200) and that on the 20th day of July, 1987, Case No. 553-B by Congregate Care Company was heard by the Board. The applicant requested a variance on the property at 680 East 100 South Street (the southwest corner of 100 South and 700 East Streets) for a special permit to erect a fence which would exceed the permitted height limit in the required front yard and for permission to eliminate a concrete block wall west of the carports in a Residential "R-6" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the intersection of Seventh East and First South and running West 247.5 feet; South 330.0 feet; East 82.5 feet; North 136.125 feet; East 165 feet; North 193.87 feet to the beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that a special permit be granted to erect a fence which would exceed the permitted height limit in the required front yard, provided the plans showing the design of the ferce are reviewed and approved by a Committee of the Board and a copy of the finally approved plan being filed in the case. If a permit has not been taken out in six months, the variance will expire.
