

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Ruth B. Rains, Sewickley of the County of Allegheny State of Pennsylvania heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided,

And whereas, the said Ruth B. Rains has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum Two hundred and no/100 (\$200.00) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State, of the State of Utah;

Now therefore, I, Herbert B. Maw Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said Ruth B. Rains and to her heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situated in the County of Carbon, State aforesaid, to wit:

The Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$); and the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section One (1), Township Thirteen (13) South, Range eight (8) East, Salt Lake Meridian.

Reserving to the United States all coal, oil gas, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove the mineral deposits as aforesaid upon compliance with the conditions and subject to ~~xxx~~ limitations of the Acts of Congress approved June 22, 1910 (36 Stat., 583) as amended by the Act of April 30, 1912, (37 Stat., 105,) Act of July 17, 1914, (38 Stat., 509.)

Reserving to the State of Utah, all minerals, other than coal, oil & gas in the above lands; and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove coal and other minerals from the same, Upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the limitations of Chapter 107, Session laws 1919, as amended 1921.

Canal and ditch right of way reserved to U.S. Act. Aug. 30th, 1890 (26 State 391)

containing Eighty and no/100 acres according to the said certificate.

I have and do hold the above described and granted premises unto the said Ruth B. Rains and to her heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same or any part thereof, and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.
