POLE LINE EASEMENT

Richard Wickel and Clara Wickel his wife, Grantors, of Summit County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alterations, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 1 guy 3 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors, in Summit County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beg. on west fence line of grantor's land at a point 1587 ft. north and 638 ft. east more or less from the south quarter corner of Sec. 24, T. 3 N. R. 4 E. S.L.B. & M. th. running N. 25°31'E. 457 ft more or less, Also beg on south fence line of grantor's land at a point 1525 ft. north and 480 ft. east more or less from the south quarter corner of Sec. 24th. running N. 24°38' W. 292 ft. more or less to north fence line of said land, and being in the N.W.¼ S.E.¼ said Sec. 24.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
