This right is granted on condition that the work shall be done with care; that all damages to the premises caused thereby shall be repaired by and at the expense of the said Company, and when it becomes necessary to change the poles or fixtures on account of the erection of new buildings or other property improvements the same shall be done by the Company at its own expense, after reasonable notice has been given the said Company by the property owner
