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PART A. PREAMBLE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, the undersigned, being the owners of the following described real property located in the City of East Layton, Davis County, State of Utah, to-wit:

Lots 41 to 80 inclusive, EAST LAYTON HILLS NO. 2 SUBDIVISION according to the plat thereof, as recorded in the office of the County Recorder of said County.

do hereby establish the nature of the use and enjoyment of all lots in said sub-division and do declare that all conveyances of said lots shall be made subject to the following conditions, restrictions and stipulations:

PART B. RESIDENTIAL AREA COVENANTS .

1. Land Use and Building Type. No lot shall be used except for residential purposes. No building shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any lot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two stories in height and private garages and/or carports for not more than three vehicles. All construction to be of new materials, except that used brick may be used with prior written approval of the Architectural Control Committee.
2. Dwelling Size. Each dwelling erected on one of the above described residential lots shall have a minimum area above ground of 1200 square feet, exclusive of garages and open porches.
3. Architectural Control. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on any lot until the construction plans and specifications and a plan showing the location of the structure have been approved by the Architectural Control Committee as to quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. No fence or wall shall be erected, placed or altered on any lot nearer to any street than the front building setback line unless similarly approve. Approval shall be as provided in Part C.
