Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 42-A across the grantors' land in the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 32 and the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 5 E., S.L.B. & M. McDonald, his wife, grantors of Heber, County of Wasatch, State of Utah, hereby grant, bargain and sell to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, Grantee, for the sum of Twenty and No/100 (\$20.00) DOLLARS, the following described right of way across the grantors' land in Wasatch County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 42-A across the grantor's land in the N 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Section 20 and SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 20, T. 3 S., R. 5 E., S.L.B. & M. Said right of way is a strip of land 40 ft. wide, 40 ft. on southwesterly side of the center line of survey of said project. said center line is described as follows:
