THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:
WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears, that pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "to Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain", and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Daniel Abra Hirschi has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the south half of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section twelve, the northwest quarter of Section thirteen, and the northeast quarter, the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, and the southwest quarter of Section fourteen in Township forty-three south of Range eleven west of the Salt Lake Mer-

idian, Utah, containing six hundred forty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the General Land Office:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said claimant the tract of land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of said claimant forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States, Excepting and reserving, however, to the United States all the coal and other minerals in the lands so entered and patented, together with the right to prospect for mine, and remove the same pursuant to the provisions and limitations of the Act of December 29, 1916 (39 Stat., 862).

In Testimony Whereof, I, Franklin D. Roosevelt, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the Eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Thirty-three and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and Fifty-Eighth.

This Deed, Made the 22d day of March, A. D. 1934, between the Rockville Corporation of THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER DAY SAINTS, a corporation sole, created and existing under the laws of Utah, party of the first part, and the Board of Education of Washington County School District, a body corporate and politic, in the county of Washington and State of Utah, party of the second part, witnesseth:

That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) & No/100th Dollars, to it paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all the following described land and premises, situated in the County of Washington, State of Utah, to-wit:

All of Lots Three (3) and Five (5) in Block Five (5) of Rockville Townsite Survey, as platted on the official Map of said Survey, and containing Fifty-six and One-half (56 1/2) square rods of land, be the same more or less.
