Whereas, there has been deposited in the general Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City Utah whereby it appears that pursuant to sections 2387, 2388 and 2389 of the Revised Statutes of the United States full payment has been made by Jacob ^{Johnson} Judge of the District Court and ex officio Probate Judge of San Juan County Utah for the north east quarter and the east half of the north west quarter of section twenty five in Township forty south of Range twenty one east of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah containing two hundred and forty acres, according to the official Plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor General.

Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Jacob Johnson the tract of land above described. To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Jacob Johnson in trust for the several use and benefit of the occupants of the Townsite of Bluff City in said County according to their respective interests and to his successors in trust as aforesaid. And there is reserved from the land hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof I Theodore Roosevelt President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twenty fourth day of September in the year of Our Lord one thousand and nine hundred and three, and of the independence of the United States the one hundred and
