\$14.00 RECEIVED OF THE MOUNTAIN STATES TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH CO. Fourteen and no/100 Dollars, in consideration of which we hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary seven poles, cables, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which we own, or in which we have any interest, in the South East quarter of the Northeast quarter of section 8, Township 2 North Range 6 East of the Salt Lake Meridian County of Summit and State of Utah and upon and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least forty-eight inches, to erect and set the necessary three anchors and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires. Provided that should it become necessary to change any of the poles, anchors, wires, or fixtures on account of the erection of new buildings or other property improvements the same shall be done by the company at its own expense, after reasonable notice has been given said company by the property owner.
