AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

The Protective Covenants of Sunset Heights Addition No. 1, Brigham City, Box Elder County, Utah, recorded in Book 123 of Records, Page 609, Records of Box Elder County, Utah, on March 13, 1959 are hereby amended in the following particulars:

1. Item One of said Protective Covenants is amended to read:
All lots in the tract shall be known and described as residential lots and no structure shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any residential building plot, other than one detached single-family dwelling, not to exceed two stories in height, and a private garage for not more than two cars, and other outbuildings incidental to residential use of plot.

No building shall be located on any lot nearer to the front lot line or

nearer to the side street line than the minimum building setback lines shown on the recorded plat. In any event no building shall be located on any lot nearer than 30 feet to the front lot line, or nearer than 20 feet to any side street line, nor nearer than 8 feet and 10 feet to an interior lot line.
