Beginning on west boundary line of grantor's land at a point 875 ft. south, more or less, from the northwest corner of Sec. 23, T. 4 S., R. 1 W., S.L.B.M., thence running S. 23° 23' E. 1210 ft. more or less, to fence on south boundary line of said land and being in the N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 said Sec. 23.
