Barnes, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the

East half of the West half and the west half of the east half of section twenty-one in township thirty-one south of range sixteen west of the Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing three hundred twenty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor-General:
