RIGHT OF WAY GRANT

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF TEN AND NO/100 Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Mary B. Bennion herself, does hereby for herself, her heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, grant and release to Mountain Fuel Supply Company, its heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove pipe lines, and erect, maintain and operate telegraph or telephone lines, if the same shall be thought necessary by said grantee, over and through Her lands in Township 3 N. Range 7 E. county of Suret, State of Utah, bounded and described as follows:

The North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the Salt Lake Base and Meridian.  
including the waiver and release of right of homestead with the right of ingress and egress to and from the same. The said Grantors to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purpose hereinbefore granted to the said Mountain Fuel Supply Company, who hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise to crops or fences from the laying, erecting, maintaining, operating or removing of said pipe, telegraph and telephone lines; said damages, if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said Mountain Fuel Supply Company, its heirs, or assigns, one by the said Grantors, their successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons, or any two of them, shall be final and conclusive. Should more than one pipe line be laid under this grant at any time, a like consideration shall be paid for each line in addition to the damages above provided for.
