AGREEMENT FOR EASEMENT AND RIGHT OF WAY .....

This agreement made this 6th day of September, 1945, between the State of Utah, through and by its State Land Board, by its duly appointed, qualified and acting Executive Secretary, grantor and the United States of America, grantee;

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the construction by the grantee of the following improvements; One windmill; 100 feet of watering troughs; 13,000 gal. storage tank; pump head on well located N 110' East 2565' from SW corner of Sec. 4, T. 30 S., R 11 W, S.L.B. & M. This well is known as the "Thermo Well" and carries State Engineers Application No. 16718

the grantor does hereby grant, bargain, convey, and confirm unto the United States of America, an easement and right of way over the tract, lot, piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Beaver, State of Utah, bounded and particularly described as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 4, Township 30 South, Range 11 West, S.L.B. & M.

The said easement and right of way hereby granted is for the full, free, unrestricted, and quiet, use and enjoyment by the grantee of the land of the said grantor, occupied by the said improvements, for any and all purposes deemed necessary or beneficial for, or in connection with, the control, administration, or use of the public land surrounding or adjacent to the land herein described, which may be properly grazed from, serviced by, or used in connection with the said land and improvements, including the right of ingress and egress to, from, and over the land of the said grantor by the grantee, its officers, agents, permittees, allottees, and licensees for the purposes of repairing, renewing, or using the said improvements, or for other business pertaining to the maintenance and use thereof, and shall be appurtenant to said public land.

This grant shall be effective as long as the said land shall be actually used for the aforesaid purposes, and all rights hereunder shall revert to the grantor when and in the event the said use thereof shall be abandoned or discontinued, of which due notice shall be given to the grantor by the grantee.
