Boyden of Coalville, Utah, grantee, for the sum of \$10.00 and other valuable consideration, the following described tract of land in Summit County, Utah, to-wit:

Commencing at the northeast corner of lot 4 of Block 79, Plat "B", Coalville City, Summit County, Utah, and running thence South 66°30' West 139.5 feet; thence South 23°30' East 53.625 feet; thence North 66°30' East 7 feet; thence North 23°30' West 21 feet 8 inches; thence North 66°30' East 132.5 feet; thence North 23°30' West 31 feet 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches to the point of beginning, situated in the Southeast quarter of Section 8 Township 2 North, Range 5 East Salt Lake Base and Meridian.
