presents shall come Greeting: Whereas, In pursuance
of the Act of Congress, approved July 2, 1862, entitled "An
Act donating Public Lands to the several States and Territories
which may provide Colleges for the benefit of Agriculture and
the Mechanic Arts;" there has been deposited in the General
Land Office Scrip No 360 for one quarter section of Land in
favor of the State of Texas, duly assigned by the proper author-
ity of the said State to William H. Society, with evidence that
the same has been located upon the East half of the South
East quarter and the South West quarter of the South East
quarter and the South East quarter of the North East quarter of
Section Twenty four in Township five North of Range Three
West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Salt Lake City
Utah Territory containing one hundred and sixty acres
according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land,
returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said William G. Scott as aforesaid and to his heirs the tract of Land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereto, unto the said William G. Scott as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection therewith such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.

In testimony whereof, I Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
