NOTICE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY

17-30-12

The following-described right-of-way was taken in 1954 for the construction of the Davis Aqueduct and is being utilized for the operation and maintenance thereof pursuant to reservation of right-of-way by the Act of August 30, 1890 (26 Stat. 391), which Act reserved a right-of-way for ditches and canals constructed by the authority of the United States. Notice is hereby given that in the use of the following-described right-of-way, the United States is not precluded or estopped from further use of right-of-way, as the need arises under the provisions and authority of the aforesaid act. Further, notice is hereby given that no use of the right-of-way should be made that is incompatible with the United States' right to operate and maintain said aqueduct.

A parcel of land in Davis County, Utah, in the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, Township 2 North, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing Twelve (12.0) acres, more or less, and being more particularly described as follows:
