RIGHT OF WAY DEED

George C. Child and Etta M. Child, his wife, grantors of----, County of----, State of Utah, hereby grant, bargain and sell to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, Grantee, for the sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS, the following described right of way across the grantors' land in Davis County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as N.R.S. Project No. 160, across the grantors' land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, T. 5 N., R. 2 W., S.L.B. & M. Said right of way is a strip of land 33 ft. wide, 33 ft. on the north side of the center line of survey of said highway. Said center line is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the east boundary line extended of said grantors' land and said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 19+83, which point is 1983 ft west along the center line of said survey from the east quarter corner of said Section 26; thence west along the approximate center of the present road, a distance of 582.0 ft. to the intersection of said center line of survey and the west boundary line extended of said grantors' land at Engineer's Station 25+65, which point is 2565 ft. west along the center line of said survey from the east quarter corner of said section 26, as shown on the official map of said project on file in the office of the State Road Commission of Utah. Above described tract of land contains 0.441 acre, of which 0.441 acre is now occupied by the existing highway. Balance 0.0 acre.

As part of the consideration for the above described highway right of way, the grantor hereby gives to the State Road Commission of Utah permission to relocate and reconstruct, within the grantor's land and outside the limits of above described right of way, all irrigation ditches existing within said limits of above described right of way.

This right of way is given on the condition that all ditches in front of said premises be cemented, and a fence put up along said farm, to-wit, being the South line forty rods long.

The purpose of this deed is to grant a perpetual right of way for highway purposes.

Emily West, grantor of Clinton County of Davis State of Utah, hereby grants, bargains and sells to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, Grantee, for the sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS, the following described right of way across the grantor's land in Davis County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as N.R.S. Project No. 160, across the grantor's land in the SE 1/4 of Section 27, T. 5 N., R. 2 W., S.L.E.& M. Said right of way is a strip of land 33 ft. wide, 33 ft. on the south side of the center line of survey of said highway. Said center line is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the east boundary line extended of said grantor's land and said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 59+16, which point 3.3 ft. south and 626.6 ft. west along the center line of said survey from the east quarter corner of said Section 27; thence west along the approximate center of the present road a distance of 696.0 ft. to the intersection of said center line of survey and the west boundary line extended of said grantor's land at Engineer's Station 66+12, which point is 3.3 ft. south and 1322.6 ft. west along the center line of said survey, from the east quarter corner of said Section 27, as shown on the official map of said project on file in the office of the State Road Commission of Utah. Above described tract of land contains 0.527 acre, of which 0.343 acre is now occupied by the existing highway. Balance 0.184 acre. This deed is made subject to the state Road Comm. laying 15 in gal. pipe from West cor of school lot west below gate entrance approx 20 rds and making hole for Waste Water off Premises.

In executing this deed, the grantor hereby grants to the State Road Commission of Utah permission to relocate and reconstruct within the grantors land and outside the limits of above described right of way, all irrigation ditches existing within said limits of above described right of way.

The purpose of this deed is to grant a perpetual right of way for highway purposes.
