Amendment to ARTICLE III, No. 6, Page 8 of the Highland Cove Condominiums DECLARATION OF. COVENANTS, CONDITIONS, AND RESTRICTIONS.

DELETE: (last two lines of paragraph): Each unit shall be maintained so as not to affect adversely the value or use of any other unit.

INSERT: Any condominium owner or owner's tenant through his or her negligence, or accident, and/or any other cause resulting in damages to their own condominium unit or to another's condominium unit within the Highland Cove Condominium Complex must pay for the cost, either through the owner's insurance payment or with the owners cash settlement, for the repair of all the resulting damages to their own and any other condominium unit suffering damages within a reasonable time frame.


