Overhead Power Easement

The Plantations at St. George L.L.C. and J. Burton & Evelyn H. Burgess Trustees, Grantors, of St. George, Washington County, State of Utah, hereby GRANTS AND CONVEYS to the City of St. George, a Utah Municipal Corporation, at 175 East 200 North, St. George, Utah 84770, Grantee, for the sum of Ten Dollars, a temporary easement exclusively for overhead power purposes, upon property in Washington County, Utah, for the purpose of constructing thereon an overhead power line and appurtenant parts thereof. No other public or private utilities may be located within the easement without the express written consent of the Grantors.

Said Overhead Power Easement is a 15-foot wide easement as shown by a drawing prepared by Rosenberg Associates titled POWER EASEMENT PLAT TO FUTURE BURGESS WELL, Rosenberg Associates Job Number 1760-7, File Number 1760-7PWR.dwg, dated Jan. 10, 2001. The basis of bearings of this easement is the North Section Line of Section 35, Township 42 South, Range 16 West of the Salt Lake Base and Meridian from the North 1/4 Corner to the Northwest Corner. The bearing is North 88°21'36" West and measures 2654.30 feet, corner to corner, based on the City of St. George Horizontal Control Network (HCN), dated August 3, 1998. Refer to the attached Exhibit A.

The following is a centerline description of the said 15-foot wide power easement, having 7.50 feet on each side of the centerline. All distances used in the following legal description are ground distances, all bearings used are HCN bearings. The side lines of this easement shall be lengthened or shortened as necessary to eliminate all gaps and overlaps at the beginning, end, and along said easement:

Beginning at a point which is North 88°21'36" West 1283.26 feet along the North Section Line of Section 35, Township 42 South, Range 16 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and South 01°38'24" West 2656.18 feet from the North 1/4 Corner of said Section 35; thence South 01°30'33" East 523.99 feet along the East Boundary Line of the property owned by The Plantations at St. George, L.L.C., as per book 1112, pages 655-657, of the Washington County Recorders Office, State of Utah; thence South 33°33'06" West 1001.17 feet to the point of termination.

Said overhead power and appurtenant parts thereof shall be constructed within the above described easement for the purpose of constructing and maintaining an overhead powerline across Grantors' land at the location described above. The City of St. George (Grantee) covenants and agrees to accept ownership of and maintain said overhead power, and appurtenant parts. Said overhead power easement is temporary only. Said Easement shall expire at the time that permanent underground power is installed to the Burgess well site and permanent easements are recorded for said permanent power.

Grantee agrees to survey the location of said easement prior to construction. Grantee agrees to install the overhead power and appurtenant parts thereof in such a manner as will reasonably cause the least possible damage or injury to Grantors' land, and will restore the land to substantially the same condition as exists immediately prior to Grantee's entry thereon.

Grantee shall have the right to enter upon Grantors' land for the purpose of maintaining, repairing, and replacing the overhead power and appurtenant parts thereof and will, immediately after such entry, restore said land to its condition as exists immediately prior to such entry. Grantor shall have the right to use the property affected by this easement for any purpose or use, so long as such use by Grantor does not interfere with or restrict Grantee's use of the said property as provided herein.
