TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20,1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts aupplemental thereto, the claim of Stella Angell Fletcher, formerly Stella Angell, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the west half of the east half and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section nineteen and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section thirty in Township six south of Range one west of the Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing two hundred eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:
