PETITION TO ROY WATER CONSERVANCY SUBDISTRICT FOR THE ALLOTMENT (P

Skeen,

Beth

(husband and wife of ROY (Guy), Utah (State), herein styled Petitioner, elects to purchase and hereby applies to the Roy Water Conservancy Subdistrict, herein styled the Subdistrict, for the allotment of the beneficial use of 62 acre-feet of water annually for the irrigation of land situated in Weber County, Utah, described as follows: (See attached description.)

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to parcels of said land in separate ownership in accordance with rules and regulations of the Subdistrict's board.

5. Project water so allotted shall be delivered at a point or points designated by the subdistrict after consultation with petitioner or his representative. It shall not be the responsibility of the Subdistrict to provide facilities to convey the water from such point or points to the place of use. The petitioner agrees to bear a pro rata share of all conveyance and evaporation losses from Weber Basin Water Conservancy District storage reservoirs to the point or point of delivery.

6. In the event there is a shortage of project water caused by drought, inaccuracy in distribution rate, resulting from negligence, handling diversion, prior or superior claim, or other causes not within the control of the Subdistrict, no liability shall accrue against the Subdistrict, or the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District, or the United States or any of their officers, agents, or employees of either of them, for any damage, direct or indirect, arising therefrom, and the payments to the Subdistrict provided for herein shall not be reduced because of any such shortage or damage. Deliveries of water allotted pursuant to this petition shall be reduced in the proportion that the number of acre-feet of such shortage, as determined by the Subdistrict, bears to the total number of acre-feet allocated for irrigation use within the Subdistrict.

7. The petitioner agrees to comply fully with all applicable Federal laws, orders and regulations, and the laws of the State of Utah, all as administered by appropriate authorities concerning the pollution of streams, reservoirs, groundwater, or water courses with respect to thermal pollution, or the discharge of refuse, garbage, sewage effluent, industrial waste, oil, mineral salts, or other pollutants.

8. The provisions of the Water Conservancy Act of Utah, and the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Directors of said Subdistrict shall be binding upon the Petitioner, and this petition shall be subject to the repayment contract between the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District and the United States dated December 12, 1953, No. 14-50-1003 as amended and any contract that may be entered into by the Subdistrict for the repayment of costs incurred by it for the construction of a distribution system, pumping plant and equalizing reservoir.

I hereby certify that the above is a true copy of petition and Order entered thereon by the Board of Directors of Roy Water Conservancy Subdistrict, on the 12th day of Oct., 1977.

3. The aggregate of the amounts so fixed in paragraphs 1 and 2 hereto shall be a tax lien upon the above described lands and shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of the Water Conservancy Act of Utah and as the same may be amended. Nothing contained in this paragraph shall be construed to exempt the petitioner from paying the taxes levied pursuant to Sections 75-4-18 and 30, Utah Code Annotated 1955, as amended.
4. The charges specified in paragraph 1 shall remain effective against the land herein described, provided that upon application to the Subdistrict, its Board of Directors may reduce the water allotted pursuant to this petition and the charges specified in paragraph 1.
