I, Deborah Kraft, being duly sworn, deposed, and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 19th day of July, 1999, case number 2472-B (Readvertised) by Marilyn H. Peterson (Applicant) was heard by the Board. The Applicant requested on the property at 1788 East Hubbard Avenue an appeal of an administrative decision holding that the removal and replacement of a foundation wall of a non-complying structure does not constitute the restoration of an unsafe structure under the Salt Lake City Zoning Ordinance Sections 21A.38.060 and 21A.38.090(C).

The legal description of the property being as follows:
