KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, hereinafter referred to a Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS and other considerations, to the undersigned in hand paid by UTAH NATURAL GAS COMPANY, a Corporation, hereinafter called Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, sell and convey unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way and easement to construct, maintain and operate a pipe line with appurtenances thereto, and road, all of which are hereinafter collectively called the "facilities", over and through the hereinafter described property, approximately alone the line designated by survey heretofore made or hereafter to be made by the Grantee, through and over the said property on a right-of way


