Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, whereby it appears that, (pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain"; and the acts supplemental thereto,) the claim of Henry Thornley, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for (the East half of the South east quart of section eight in township four north of range one west in the district of lands subject to sale, at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, containing eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.)

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said

Henry Thornley the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Henry Thornley and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

In testimony whereof, I, Rutherford B. Hayes, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Hammon of Hooper in the County of Davis and Territory of Utah, party of the first part, and William Prieste of Hooper, Davis County and Territory aforesaid, the party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in Hooper County aforesaid known and described as follows, to wit:

Two chains (2) thirty seven links (37) west of the south east quarter of the North East quarter of Section Twenty five (25) Township five (5) North Range Three (3) West, Salt Lake Meridian, running north nine chains (9) thirteen links (13) in the middle of a certain four rod street to a setting rock in middle of a
