Beginning at a point North 351.52 feet and East 652.11 feet from the South Quarter Corner of Section 5, Township 5 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian; thence North 0°45'49" East 32.48 feet; thence South 89°52'38" East 148.51 feet; thence South 0°45'49" West 122.48 feet; thence North 87°13'08" West 27.92 feet; thence North 84°21'12" West 28.80 feet; thence North 87°43'55" West 19.61 feet; thence North 89°29'56" West 72.29 feet to the point of beginning;

With regard to this Quit Claim, Grantees agree to forever waive their rights and release and indemnify and hold harmless Grantor from any liability under CERCLA, and specifically under Sections 107(a) and 113(f) of CERCLA, subsequent changes, modifications, or additions to CERCLA's provisions, as well as any other federal, state or local statute, regulation or common law right that exists or that may be enacted in the future, allowing Grantee or any other party to pursue a claim, demand, or cause of action against Grantor for reimbursement, contribution, or any other payment or service in any way related to environmental investigation or clean-up of subject property. Grantees and Grantor warrant and agree that this provision does not constitute an admission of any environmental liability by Grantees.

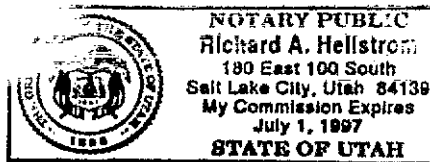

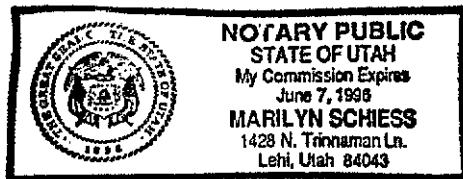
