EASEMENT

For the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned GRANTORS' hereby grant, convey, sell and set over unto the Salt Lake City Suburban Sanitary District No. 2, a body politic of the State of Utah, hereinafter referred to as GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, a perpetual right-of-way and easement to lay, maintain, operate, repair, inspect, protect, install, remove and replace sewer pipelines, manholes, laterals and other sewer collection and transmission structures and facilities, hereinafter called FACILITIES, said perpetual right-of-way and easement being situated in Salt Lake County, State of Utah, over and through a parcel of the GRANTORS' land lying within a strip twenty (20) feet wide, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North right of way line of 7500 South (Greenwood Avenue) said point being North 0°00'05" East along the Section line 2034.78 feet, West 177.47 feet and North 89°38'51" West 38.00 feet from the Southeast Quarter of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and running thence North 0°36'02" East 290.00 feet.

The basis of bearing being South 89°39'41" East 157.42 feet from the Southeast Quarter of Section 25 to a found witness corner for the Southeast Corner of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 1 West.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, so long as such FACILITIES shall be maintained, with the right of ingress and egress in said GRANTEE, its officers, employees, representatives, agents and assigns to enter upon the above described property with such equipment as is necessary to install, maintain, operate, repair, inspect, protect, remove and replace said FACILITIES. During construction periods, GRANTEE and its agents may use such portion of GRANTORS' property along and adjacent to said right-of-way as may be reasonably necessary in connection with the construction or repair of said FACILITIES. The Contractor performing the work shall restore all property, through which the work traverses, to as near its original condition as is reasonably possible.

GRANTORS' shall have the right to use said premises except for the purpose for which this right-of-way and easement is granted to the said GRANTEE, provided such use shall not interfere with the FACILITIES or with the discharge and conveyance of sewage through said FACILITIES, or any other rights granted to the GRANTEE hereunder.

GRANTORS' shall not build or construct or permit to be built or constructed over or across said right-of-way, any building or other improvement nor change the contour thereof without the written

consent of GRANTEE. This right-of-way and easement grant shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of the GRANTORS' and the successors and assigns of the GRANTEE, and may be assigned in whole or in part by GRANTEE.
