5. John W. Roundy and Mina M. Roundy his wife, Grantors, of Juab County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and no guy anchors - 28 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors, in Juab County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning at fence on north boundary line of grantor's land at a point 1320 feet north and 150 feet west, more or less, from the south quarter corner of Section 34, T. 10 N., R. 1 E., S.L.B.&M., thence running S. 7°59' W. 6172 feet, thence S. 8°00' W. 1956.5 feet to fence on south boundary line of said land; also beginning at fence on north boundary line of grantor's land at a point 1260 feet east, more or less, from the west quarter corner of Section 19, T. 11 S., R. 1 E., S.L.B.&M., thence running S. 8°00' W. 2705.5 feet to fence on south boundary line of said land; also beginning on north boundary line of grantor's land at a point 20 feet east, more or less, from the northwest corner of Section 22, T. 11 S.
