containing 1864.25 acres according to the said certificate

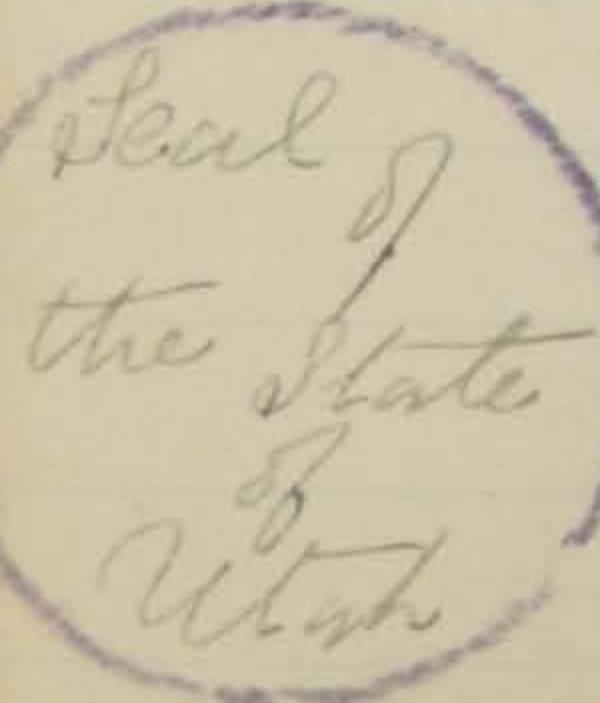
