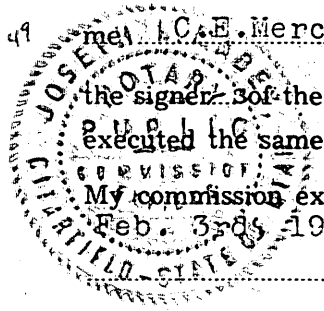

Beginning at fence on east boundary line of Grantor's land at a point 1380 feet south and 1320 feet east, more or less, from the northwest corner of Section 33, T. 4 S., R. 1 E., S.L.B. & M., thence running S. 88°58' W. 1256 feet to west boundary line of said land at east fence of County Road and being in the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 33.

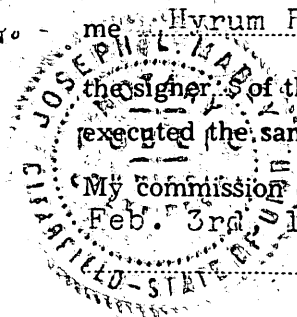

Company, a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 2 guy anchors 8 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Utah County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning in existing power line over Grantor's land at a point 1440 feet south and 2200 feet west, more or less, from the northeast corner of Section 34, T. 8 S., R. 3 E., S.L.B. & M., thence running S. 46°55' E. 1466 feet to and including additional two pole extension to existing switchrack on Grantor's land and being in the S 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of said Section 34.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
