5. UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY  
Pole Line Easement

J. Edwin Ure and Jean Ure, his wife, Grantors of Summit County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration and replacement of the electric transmission distribution and telephone curcuits of the Grantee, and 2 guy anchors and 8 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon or affixed thereto for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors in Summit County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning on South boundary line of grantor's land at a point 910 feet east more or less, from the Southwest corner of Section 24, T. 2 S. R. 5 E. S.L.B.&M. thence running N. 44°34' E. 3130 feet, more or less to fence on north boundary line of said land and being in the S½ of the SW¼, the NE¼ of the SW¼ and the NW¼ of the SE¼ of said Section 24,.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or inerfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
