LAMBERT and DOROTHY LAMBERT, his wife, Grantors of Summit County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar and other valuable consideration a easement and right of way for the erection, and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee and no guy anchors and no towers or poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor in Summit County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning at west right of way line of State Highway No. 4 on east boundary line of grantor's land at a point 745 feet north and 235 feet east, more or less, from the southwest corner of Section 24, T. 2 S. R. 5 E. S.L.S.&M. thence running S 80°12' W. 240 feet, more or less, to west boundary line of said land and being in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 24.

This Easement will terminate November 1, 1954.
