KENDALL and PAUL KENDALL of Nephi, Utah, grantees, for the sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-eight and 66/100 (\$6,268.66) Dollars, and other good and valuable considerations, all its right, title and interest in and to the following described tract of land in Juab County, State of Utah, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21); Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$); West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Ten (10) South, Range One (1) East; Salt Lake Meridian, containing in all Three Hundred Twenty (320) acres, more or less, together with any and all buildings, improvements and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

Excepting therefrom the following described land which was quit claim deeded to Merrill L. Oldroyd of Payson, Utah, under date of August 2, 1915:
