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

QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, for and in consideration of the sum of FOUR THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE and NO/100 Dollars, (\$4,375.00), does hereby convey, sell, and quitclaim unto LEO MARCHBANKS and HELEN MARCHBANKS, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety with the right of survivorship, of Pleasant Grove, County of Utah, State of Utah, all its right title, claim, interest, equity, and estate in and to the following described lands lying in the County of Utah, State of Utah, to-wit:

TOWNSHIP SIX (6) SOUTH, RANGE TWO (2)
EAST, OF SALT LAKE MERIDIAN

SECTION 4:

That certain parcel of land situated in the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 4 described as follows, to-wit:

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9500-37
1/16 of 225 1/2
Commencing at the center of Section 4,
thence North 10.12 chains; thence East
13.5 chains to the West line of the
railroad right of way; thence South
23°17' East along the West line of said
railroad right of way 11.02 chains;
thence West 17.85 chains to beginning.

INCLUDING NINE (9) shares of water in
the North Union Irrigation Company.

RESERVING all oil, gas, coal, and other mineral rights of whatsoever nature upon, in or under the said lands, together with the usual mining rights, powers and privileges, including the right of access to and the use of such parts of the surface as may be necessary for mining and saving said minerals.

SUBJECT, however, to the reservations and exceptions contained in the Patent from the United States of America and to such easements and rights of way upon, across, or through the above described lands as heretofore have been granted by the United States of America or its predecessors in title for the construction, operation and maintenance of public utility systems, streets, roads, and walks.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Grantees and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

This conveyance is executed and delivered by virtue of the authority delegated by the War Food Administrator to the Administrator of the Farm Security Administration by delegation of authority dated March 13, 1944, appearing in Federal Register dated March 16, 1944 (Vol. 9, page 2840), and redelegated by the Administrator of the Farm Security Administration to Regional Directors of said Administration by redelegation of authority dated April 27, 1944, appearing in Federal Register dated April 29, 1944 (Vol. 9, page 4523).
