ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING

CEDAR MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

COMES NOW The Board of County Commissioners, Kane County, Utah, to enact an ordinance establishing the following:

1. The Board of County Commissioners, Kane County, Utah, declares that the Cedar Mountain Fire Protection District is hereby established; and

2. The boundaries of the CEDAR MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT are as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the West right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 89 and the North boundary line of Kane County (near the Northeast corner of Section 2 Township 38 South, Range 6 West), and running thence West along the Kane County boundary line to the Northwest Corner of Section 3, Township 38 South, Range 9 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian; thence South to the Southwest Corner of Section 15, Township 38 South, Range 9 West; thence East to Northwest Corner of Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 8 West; thence South to the Southwest Corner of Section 36, Township 38 South Range 8 West; thence East to the West right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 89 (near the Southeast Corner of Section 33, Township 38 South, Range 6 West); thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way line to the point of beginning.

EXPRESSLY EXCLUDING all portions situated with Harris Spring Ranches, Ponderosa Villa Plats A through H, Strawberry Valley Estates Units 1 through 4, Swains Creek Pines Subdivision Units 1 through 4, and Swains Creek Subdivision Unit 1.

3. The property within the boundaries of the District is more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1: All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15, Township 38 South, Range 9 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

PARCEL 2: All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 24, 25 and 36, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

PARCEL 3: All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17,
