RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

ARCADIAN PARK SUBDIVISION

1. All lots in the tract shall be known and described as residential lots, and no structure shall be erected on any residential building plot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two stories

erected on any residential building plot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two stories in height and one or two-car garage.
