

The Court further finds that in Anticle Four of the Will, Decedent intended to leave her homestead or primary residence to her spouse, and that the reference to her spouse as herself is also a typographical error. The Court finds that the intent was to bequeath Decedent's homestead or primary residence to her husband, Edward J. Zayac.

The Court finds that under Section 254.002 of the Estates Code that Edward J. Zayac as a beneficiary of Decedent's estate is also a subscribing witness. The Court finds that Edward J. Zayac is entitled to the same share of Decedent's estate listed in the Will had Decedent died intestate. The Court finds that proper testimony from a disinterested and credible person was presented to the Court which corroborates the intent of Decedent to bequeath her entire estate to Edward J. Zayac.
