DRINKING WATER SOURCE PROTECTION PLAN ST. GEORGE CITY WASHINGTON COUNTY, UTAH

We, the undersigned landowner, acknowledge the Drinking Water Source Protection Plan for the City of St. George's Tolman Well #4. We agree to not locate or allow the location of uncontrolled potential contamination sources or pollution sources, as defined in R309-113-6(1)(w) of the Utah Administrative Code (attached), within zone one. Zone one is the area within a 100-foot radius from the wellhead.


More particularly described as a 100.00 foot radius circle being the perimeter boundary for zone one of Tolman Well #4, the center of which is described as follows: beginning at a point N89°46'26" E 957.22 feet along the Section Line and S00°00'00"W 317.78 feet from the East ¼ Corner of Section 23, Township 41 South, Range 16 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian said point being the center of a 100.00 foot radius circle being the perimeter boundary of said zone one.

The extent of zone one is portrayed on the attached figure, herein incorporated by reference as part of this agreement. The portion of zone one that is covered by this agreement encompasses approximately 0.72 acres.

If at such time, the well is abandoned as a drinking water source for the City of St. George, then this Land Use Agreement is considered null and void. This agreement is binding on all heirs, successors and assigns.
