## POLE LINE EASEMENT

San Francisco Chemical Company, a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 4 guy anchors and 3 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Wasatch County, Utah along a line described as follows:

Beginning in an existing power line on the Grantor's land at a point 1220 feet south and 650 feet east, more or less, from the west one quarter corner of Section 6, T. 2 S., R. 5 E., S.L.M., thence N. 77° 20' E. 589 feet on said land and being in Lot 6 of said Section 6.
