POLE LINE EASEMENT

COOPERATIVE SECURITY CORPORATION, a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 4 guy anchors and 17 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Utah County, Utah along a line described as follows:

Beginning in an existing power line on the Grantors' land at a point 17 feet south and 3628 feet west, more or less, from the east one quarter corner of Section 14, T. 6 S., R. 2 W., S.L.M., thence S. 89° 55' E. 6280 feet, thence S. 0° 05' W. 580 feet on said land and being in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and the N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 14, and the N 1/2 of the SW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township and Range aforesaid.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.

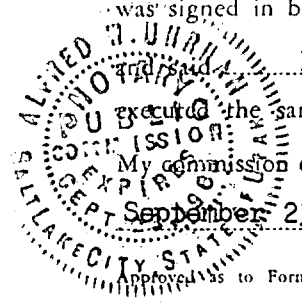
