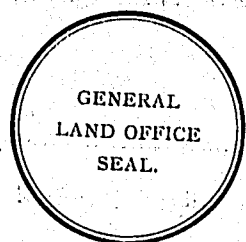

Golle according to the provisions of theAct of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the sections one two three ten twelve thirteen fifteen twenty two and twenty five in Township thirteen south of range fifty four west of the sixth Principal Meridian in Colorado containing five thousand seven hundred and fifty acres and thirty one hundredths of an acreaccording to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Emanuel C.
