Whitlock Grantee of Evanston City Cook County, Illinois for the sum of One Dollar<sup>2d</sup> and other valuable considerations the following described tract of land in Box Elder County, State of Utah: the South one-half (S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) of Section twenty-eight (28)<sup>2d</sup> and the North three hundred<sup>2d</sup> and twenty (320) acres of Section thirty-four (34) all in Township nine (9) North, Range seven (7) West of the Salt Lake Meridian.

Subject to the condition that unless within ninety days from <sup>the</sup> date hereof standard oil well

drilling machinery be placed in operation within one<sup>2d</sup> one-half (1½) miles from said section 34 and unless work be continued until a well is sunk to a depth of one thousand feet (unless it be sooner struck in paying quantities) this deed shall become void<sup>2d</sup> said land shall revert to the grantors

Witness the hands of the said grantors, this 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, A.D. one thousand nine hundred and four

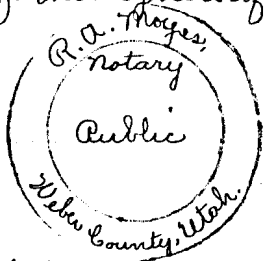
