his wife, Grantor, of Salt Lake County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant... to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and no guy anchors and two ~~wooden~~ poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Salt Lake County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

One new pole in existing line over Grantors' land and one new pole twenty feet north at right angle to new pole in line which is located at a point 1330 feet north and 265 feet west, more or less, from the southeast corner of Section 28, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., S.L.B. & M., and being in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 28.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation, or enjoyment of this easement.

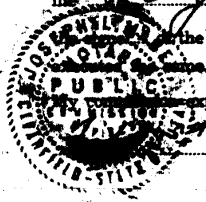
