ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Deborah Martin, being duly sworn, deposed and say that I am the Secretary for the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 15th day of November 2004, case number 2758-B by Joshua M. Yenny (Applicant) was heard by the Board. The Applicant requested for the property at 1819 South 1100 East special exception to allow a conditional home occupation for a handyman service in an R-1/5000 Zone.

The legal description of the property being as follows:

It was moved, seconded and passed to grant the special exception to allow a conditional home occupation for a handyman business service at 1819 South 1100 East in an R-1/5000 Single-Family Residential zoning district because:


1. The home occupation will be in compliance with Ordinance and district purposes.
